Credit Transfer

80CP Credit Transfer will be awarded towards the Bachelor of Business for completion of the Diploma of Venue Management 10569NAT (17 Units) and the superseded CUE50403 Diploma of Venues and Events (21 units). Students can complete the Bachelor of Business in 2 years full-time study (or part-time equivalent), commencing in February, July or October.

The Bachelor of Business is offered full-time and part-time on-campus at the Gold Coast campus. You may choose to study courses at other campuses or online if or where the program structure allows.
