#### **Program Information**

In the Bachelor of International Tourism and Hotel Management, you will gain an in-depth understanding of the tourism sector, underscored by sustainability principles. You will be prepared for work in a range of international tourism and hotel management roles, including in hotel and resort groups and the accommodation sector, in independent restaurants and internationally recognised chains, with entertainment and leisure providers, with suppliers of goods and services to the hospitality industry, and with local, state and federal tourism and regional planning authorities.

#### **Credit Transfer**

80CP Credit Transfer will be awarded towards the Bachelor of International Tourism and Hotel Management for completion of the Diploma of Venue Management 10569NAT (17 Units) and the superseded CUE50403 Diploma of Venues and Events (21 units). Students can complete the Bachelor of International Tourism and Hotel Management in 2 years full-time study (or part-time equivalent), commencing in February or July.
